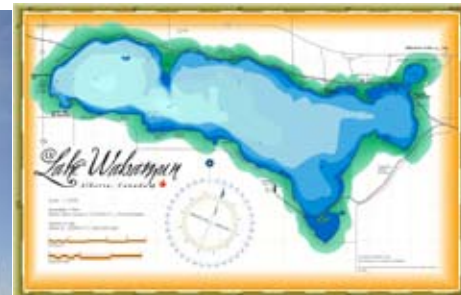
## Update from Facilities
