## **Condition:**

The boat has been well maintained and is in great operating condition and ready to sail. It has been completely overhauled over the years following acquisition by the current owner.

The overhaul has included new Harken 2 speed winches, Schaffer Bridge Traveller, all deck hardware (Harken), stay and halyard replacement, hinged mast step, new deck, hull and bottom paint, lifelines replaced, reupholstered interior cushions. New Lexan hatch on foredeck and cabin. New push-pit rail around cockpit. Rudder shaft re-sleeved during retrofit.

The boat has been stored in a heated shop over winter months and sailed in fresh water on Lake Wabamun since 2000.



**Sails:**

Dacron loose-footed full battened Mainsail, Kevlar 154% #1, 3Di Nordac #2, Dacron #3, Dacron storm jib, asymmetrical spinnaker, Gennaker with snuffer sock. The Mainsail and foresails are stored in roll bags when not in use. All sails and associated sheets are in great condition. Spinnaker pole and whisker pole onboard.



**Motor:** 2005 Nissan (Tohatsu) 6 hp, 4 stroke, long shaft outboard, manual start.

**Trailer:** McCoy Bros. tandem axle trailer with surge brakes. Wheel bearings and brakes have recently been serviced. Trailer has hitch extension and fold down support wheel for ramp launching.

**Electrical:** The boat was rewired in 2005 complete with new Marine Breaker Panel. A 12 volt battery is required to run the lights.

**Extras:** Life Sling Floatation Device, life jackets, new Porta Potty, spare Impeller and spark plug (for outboard), swim ladder, fenders and dock lines, Danforth anchor c/w chain and rope rode, compass, hand-held VHF marine radio, ratchet load straps, cabin top mast supports for horizontal mast transportation, plastic fuel tank, floating winch handle.

The sink and stove are original and have not been used by the current owner.
