
# SWAME BAY JIB SHEET

## Clubhouse Etiquette

#### **Respect Each Other**

Show kindness, understanding, and consideration to everyone in the clubhouse. Remember that everyone is there to enjoy the space, indoors and out.



#### Keep it Clean

Clean up after yourself and contribute to a tidy clubhouse. Wash, dry and put away all of your used dishes. Also please clean toilet and sink areas after you use them, if they require cleaning. Take boat and trailer garbage home with you, the dumpster is only for clubhouse garbage.





#### Pitch In

Please volunteer where you can to help if needed for events or general upkeep of the club. Facilities and events are provided for your benefit but are much more enjoyable when there's lots of help!



## Trailers / Parking Lot

Request temporary camping in the parking lot by contacting vice\_commodore@sunshinebay.org or membership@sunshinebay.org PRIOR to arrival. Limited spaces available for \$25/night

#### **Respect Septic Capacity**

Our septic tank is only so big! Please keep showers short and do not flush anything other than small amounts of TP.



#### **Pets**

We love pets, but only when they're leashed and stay off the deck during club events. Otherwise, they can be leashed and with their owners on the northwest corner of the deck (against the clubhouse), but never inside.



#### **Food Storage**

Use Green Shack Fridge/Freezer **only**, keep clubhouse fridge for Event food.



#### **CLUB WIFI**

The clubhouse has Starlink WiFi for the members to access. The password for the network is posted on the inside of the clubhouse, on the bulletin board. Some have reported that the reach goes out to the docks / parking lot / camping areas!


#### **CLUB CONNECTIONS**



Please be aware: A live camera view of the docks is now available for SBYC members only. Please refer to the Members Only area of the website for instructions to download the Reolink app, and retrieve login information.

The camera is installed on the roof of the clubhouse above the deck, and has a very limited view of the deck. The picture to the left is the field of view. If you have questions or concerns about the camera, please reach out a Board member.
