

San Juan 23 sailboat for sale “Déjà Blue”

A former SBYC member and board member is selling his San Juan 23 sailboat with swing keel, dual-axle trailer, and three-year-old outboard motor. The boat had been in Wabamun Lake for many years before being moved to the West Coast.



The fiberglass-hull boat (1978) is in good condition, weighs 2,500 lbs., is 23 feet long, 8 feet wide, with a draft of 2 feet (daggerboard up) or 4 feet 9 inches (daggerboard down). The keel was treated with an anti-foul agent at the end of the 2022 sailing season, so it is good for another two years. The boat was surveyed in 2021 and valued at \$12,000 (survey available for viewing). Asking \$10,000 or best offer.
