## Notice of Race

### Single Handed Race

July 8, 2023

#### 1. Rules

**1.1** The Race will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing and the Sail Canada Prescriptions 2017-2020*

#### 2. Eligibility

**2.1** The Regatta is open to all sailors who hold a valid membership with either the *Edmonton Yacht Club* or the *Sunshine Bay Yacht Club* (others by exception).

#### 3. Fees

**3.1** All registrations must be completed through the website race registration form.

**3.2** Registrations will be accepted up to 1800h, Friday July 7<sup>th</sup>. Visit the race registration form to obtain fee information.

**3.3** Fees are preferred payable by e transfer to [fees@sunshinebay.org](mailto:fees@sunshinebay.org) or payable by cash or cheque payable to SBYC or Sunshine Bay Yacht Club

#### 4. Awards

**4.1** Awards will be announced via email on Sunday July 9<sup>th</sup>.

**4.2** Awards will be made to the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place finishing boats.

**4.3** All boats will be placed for their finish based on their 2022 PHRF handicap rating.

#### 5. Schedule

**5.1** Skippers Meeting at 9 am July 8, SBYC clubhouse. Updates will be posted via email.

**5.2** Sailing Instructions will be made available to all Registered Skippers

**5.3** Start of race: 11:00 am (warning gun at 1055h)

**5.4** Number of races: One

#### 6. Course

**6.1** The course length will be approximately 15 nautical miles. Actual Course length, course diagram and GPS location of the Race Marks will be available on the SBYC website or emailed to Registered Skippers.

#### 7. Classes

**7.1** All boats will race in one Fleet.

**7.2** A minimum of 5 boats must be registered for this event to take place.

#### 8. Scoring

**8.1** One completion (lap) of the course will constitute completion of the race.

**8.2** Final finish time will be determined after applying PHRF correction factors.

**9. Radio Communications**

- 9.1** Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communications that are not available to all boats.
- 9.2** The Race Officer may communicate with the race fleet on channel 72.

**10. Disclaimer of Liability**

- 10.1** Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.
- 10.2** The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

**11. Insurance**

- 11.1** Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$1,000,000.00 per incident or the equivalent.

**12. Rights to Use Name and Likeness**

- 12.1** In participating in this event, a competitor automatically grants the *Organizing Authority* and the sponsors the right in perpetuity, to make, use or show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition for the said event in which the competitor participates and in all material related to the said event without compensation.
