TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. DEFINITIONS

5050. All definitions from the Act and the Regulations apply except where expressly defined in this approval.

5060. In all parts of this Approval:

- a. "Act" means the Water Act, RSA 2000, c. W-3, as amended;
- b. "Application" means the written submissions to the Director in respect of application number DAPP0001118 and any subsequent applications for amendments of Approval Number DAUT0008356;
- c. "Director" means an employee of the Government of Alberta designated as a Director under the Act;
- d. "Regulations" means the regulations, as amended, enacted under the authority of the Act.
- e. "Water Body" means Wabamun Lake within the Province of Alberta and Parkland County;

2. GENERAL

5200. The Approval Holder shall immediately report to the Director by telephone, any contravention of the terms and conditions of this approval at 1-780-422-4505.

5210. The terms and conditions of this Approval are severable. If any term or condition of this Approval is held invalid, the application of such term or condition to other circumstances and the remainder of this Approval shall not be affected thereby.

5220. The Approval Holder shall not deposit or cause to be deposited any substance in, on, or around the water body that has, or may have, the potential to adversely affect the water body.

5230. The Approval Holder shall retain a copy of this Approval at the site of the activity.

3. PARTICULARS

5240. This Approval is appurtenant to the activity described as aquatic vegetation cutting in



Wabamun Lake as described in DAPP0001118-P001, as specified in 5250.

5250. The Approval Holder shall only undertake the Activity in accordance with the following plan.

DAPP0001118-P001: Plan titled "Water License of Occupation 820441 For Sunshine Bay Yacht Club Temporary Docks License Area 1.14HA (+/-)", submitted with the Application.

5260. The Approval Holder shall retain a copy of the report(s) and plan(s) referred to in 5250 at the site of the Activity at all times while conducting the Activity.

5270. The Approval Holder shall not undertake the Activity in any manner or use any material that causes or may cause an adverse effect on the aquatic environment, human health, property or public safety.

5340. The Approval Holder shall not conduct the Activity in the Water Body between September 16 and July 31 unless:

(a) the water body is dry or

(b) frozen down to the bed; or

(c) the written recommendations and specifications of a qualified aquatic environment specialist is obtained; or

(d) is authorized in writing by the Director.

4. AQUATIC VEGETATION

5940. The Approval Holder shall not cut aquatic vegetation to a depth of more than 1 metre beneath the surface of the water body, unless otherwise authorized in writing by the Director.

5950. The Approval Holder shall:

(a) immediately remove all cut aquatic vegetation from the Water Body; and

(b) dispose of the cut aquatic vegetation at a location where nutrients and debris from the cut aquatic vegetation will no re-enter any water body.

5960. The Approval Holder shall not cut the aquatic vegetation more than once per open water

season.

5970. The Approval Holder shall limit the width of aquatic vegetation cutting to no more than 2 m wide on any of side of each dock shown on Plan DAPP0001118-P001.

5980. The Approval Holder shall select a location of cutting such that:

- (a) existing stands of dense aquatic vegetation are not located within the cutting area; and
- (b) existing areas of little to no vegetation are located within the cutting area.

5. SILTATION AND EROSION CONTROL

5480. The Approval Holder shall not do or permit anything to be done, nor omit or permit any omissions, which causes or may cause an adverse effect related to:

- (a) siltation; or
- (b) erosion

as a result of the activity.

5490. The Approval Holder shall:

- (a) develop a written Siltation and Erosion Control Plan prior to commencing the activity;
- (b) implement the Siltation and Erosion Control Plan; and
- (c) retain a copy of the Siltation and Erosion Control Plan at the site of the Activity at all times while conducting the Activity.

6. CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION

6050. The Approval Holder shall submit a Certificate of Completion to the Director within 30 days following completion of the Activity.

6060. The Certificate of Completion shall include:

- (a) a statement that the activity has been completed in accordance with the Approval; and



(b) any other information requested in writing by the Director.
